## The Rising Cost of Care for Diabetes

## Average Direct Costs of Diabetes Care Hospital Inpatient Care



\$4,966 annually for people with diabetes, \$2,819 is directly attributable to diabetes

Prescription Drugs and Antidiabetes Supplies

\$6,325 annually for people with diabetes, \$4,333 is directly attributable to diabetes


### **Physician Office Visits**

**\$2,099** annually for people with diabetes, **\$1,213** is directly attributable to diabetes


#### **Other Expenditures**

**\$3,364** annually for people with diabetes, **\$1,236** is directly attributable to diabetes

## Outpatient Medications and Supplies Specific to Individuals with Diabetes

Average annual expenditures per person with diabetes: \$6,325

#### Insulin

Insulin costs an average of \$606 annually, with significant variability relating to formulary, insurance, and list price modifications



# Antidiabetes Agents and Supplies

Antidiabetes agents and supplies cost an average of \$978 annually





#### Prescription Medications

Prescription medications used in the treatment of complications associated with diabetes or for other reasons cost an average of \$4,741 annually
