Department of Health and Human Services Title XX Social Services Block Grant

The Department of Health and Human Services intends to use the federal Title XX Social Services Block Grant for the period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 to fund the following services: Adoption, Case Management, Counseling, Day Care for Children, Employment, Foster Care for Children, Health-Related, Home-Based Services, Prevention and Intervention, Protective Services for Adults, Protective Services for Adults, Protective Services for Children, Residential Treatment, Special Services for Persons with Developmental or Other Physical Disabilities, Substance Abuse, Transportation Services and Basic Needs for Disaster Relief for the residents of Fernley affected by the floods in 2008.

These services are available to individuals residing in Nevada who request services, are determined in need of services, and who meet the eligibility requirements. Service availability varies by geographic area.
