**STATE TO PROVIDE CHILD SUPPORT
ENFORCEMENT SERVICES FOR CARSON CITY**

Carson City—The Nevada Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS) will begin providing Child Support Enforcement Program (CSEP) services previously operated by the Carson City District Attorney's Office for Carson City on December 10, 2007. Child support services for Carson City residents will transition to DWSS's Reno Program Area Office (PAO), located at 300 East Second Street, Suite 1200.

Families receiving child support services in Carson City will experience no disruption in services during or after this transition period. Currently, there are approximately 2,100 child support cases being served by the Carson City District Attorney Office.

Carson City residents seeking child support enforcement services can obtain program applications from the DWSS website (<http://welfare.state.nv.us/child.htm>), the Carson City District Attorney Office (located at 885 E. Musser, Suite 2030A), or by calling the Reno PAO at (775) 448-5150. Completed applications may be dropped off at the DWSS office located at 1470 College Parkway in Carson City, or can be mailed to:
