Carson City—National Survivors of Suicide Day is November 17, 2007. To commemorate the day, Crisis Call Center of Northern Nevada will host its eleventh annual Candlelight Vigil in remembrance of loved ones lost to suicide. Misty Vaughan Allen, Nevada State Suicide Prevention Coordinator, will be among several invited speakers who will share their experiences. A candle-lighting ceremony will also take place. Survivors of suicide will gather in a supportive and safe environment to discuss how the loss of a loved one profoundly affected their lives, and to help each other in the healing process.

About 60 people are expected to attend. The vigil is open to the public, as well.
