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**Personal Assistance Services Available
to Nevadans with Severe Physical Disabilities**

If you, or someone you know, is an adult with severe physical disabilities, and need help paying for personal care services, funding is available. The Nevada Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD) can provide financial assistance to adults with severe physical disabilities through the Personal Assistance Services (PAS) program. The PAS program pays for assistance with activities of daily life which allows clients to remain in their own homes and avoid placement in a long-term care facility. The PAS program provides community-based, in-home services to Nevadans with physical disabilities who need help with bathing, toileting, eating, dressing, hygiene, mobility, and meal preparation. The PAS program pays for up to 35 hours a week for activities of daily living, and an additional 14 hours a week of supportive services to people with traumatic brain injuries.
