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This task force has identified the need for a strong collaborative effort in Nevada in order to increase GME. It is important that this effort continues to look at the need of the state overall, as opposed to the specific need in one area. The following is a proposed plan to achieve this goal:

- 1) Creation of a GME board as presented, which would represent a wide variety of health workforce stakeholders and would coordinate and prioritize GME funds and positions based on evidence of need.
- 2) Development of a sustainable funding model that include the discussed funding strategies.
- 3) Institution of strategy for ongoing program evaluation and accountability for Graduate Medical Education spending.
- 4) Implementation of a state resident tracking system to assess its return on investment for GME monies spent on expansion and development of GME programs. This should include tracking retention of Nevada residents.
