BACKGROUND

- DHHS budget authority for problem gambling programs increased leading to increased funds earmarked for PGS workforce development (\$43K).
- We want to utilize this opportunity to assess our current situation and future needs in order to revise the DHHS Problem Gambling Services Strategic Plan's workforce development section.

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- **Goal**

- Recruit, develop and sustain a qualified problem gambling services workforce.

- **Task**

- Workforce Development Workgroup to provide input and recommendations for meeting workforce development needs.
- **Deliverable:** Recommendations will be used to form a plan as to how allocated WFD funds will be programmed.

- **Time-line**

- Limited duration workgroup will meet three times between September and November 2019.
