Reporting Date: On or before April 1

Reporting Frequency: Annually

Form Template Name: "PBM Reporting template vmm.dd.yy"

Purpose: NRS 439B.645 requires that Pharmacy Benefit Managers (PBMs) report on the amount of rebates negotiated for the drugs included on the most current list compiled by the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) pursuant to NRS 439B.630.

Instructions:

- 1. The department's excel template provides PBMs with a standardized form to use for reporting that incorporates all the fields required by law.
- 2. All fields listed in the template document are required fields, unless otherwise noted.
- 3. The departmental template headers should not be rearranged or changed in any way.
- 4. All values should be reported with data specific to Nevada.
- 5. All rebate amounts should be listed in United States dollars.
- 6. Rebates should be reported separately for essential diabetes and asthma drugs by using the worksheet tabs labeled "Diabetes" and "Asthma".
