# Prescription Drug Program

- Total Funding: \$313,132
- Reductions from SFY25
  - SFY26 - \$45,834
  - SFY27 - \$44,975
- Impacts
  - Potential for waitlists
  - Will not be able to expand statewide
- Total Applications: 8 applications
  - 1 existing applicant, 7 new applicants
  - Top Score: 86 – Access to Healthcare Network

# Senior Services

- Non-Competitive Process for SFY2026
- SFY2026 Total: \$5,656,428
  - Reduction: \$962,322
- Total Subawards: 51
  - In-Home Services: \$3,420,735.73
  - Transportation: \$2,032,831.33
  - Assisted Living Supportive Services: \$200,000



# Nevada 211

## Reduction in SFY26/27 Funding

- SFY26 \$109,486
- SFY27 \$107,318

## Impacts

Working with vendor to evaluate options now.

Nevada 211 Call Specialists are in the lowest tier of pay in the nation.

Considering reduction of hours, reducing outreach efforts, and evaluating App maintenance.
