Recommendation Scoring Methodology

Recommendations rated based on:

Impact (1–5)

- Number of lives affected
- Magnitude of impact on individuals
- Impact to health equity

Urgency

(1-5)

- Availability of alternatives
- Risk/Consequences of delay in implementation

Feasibility

(1-5)

- Current infrastructure availability
- Ease of implementation (effort)
- Availability of resources for implementation (staff, community, and relative financial)

Legislative Target (0 or 3)

- Overdose prevention
- Addressing disparities in access to healthcare
- Prevention of substance use among youth

Recommendations can be sorted by impact, urgency, feasibility, and scores, as well as filtered by legislative target.

Total priority scores calculated across impact, urgency, and feasibility, taking into account whether the recommendation is a legislative target.

Total Score Range: 3-18

Recommendations categorized by allowable expenditure categories in legislation.



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
